Betty Jean will enter the University of Georgia in September.



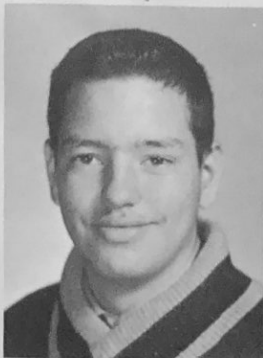
