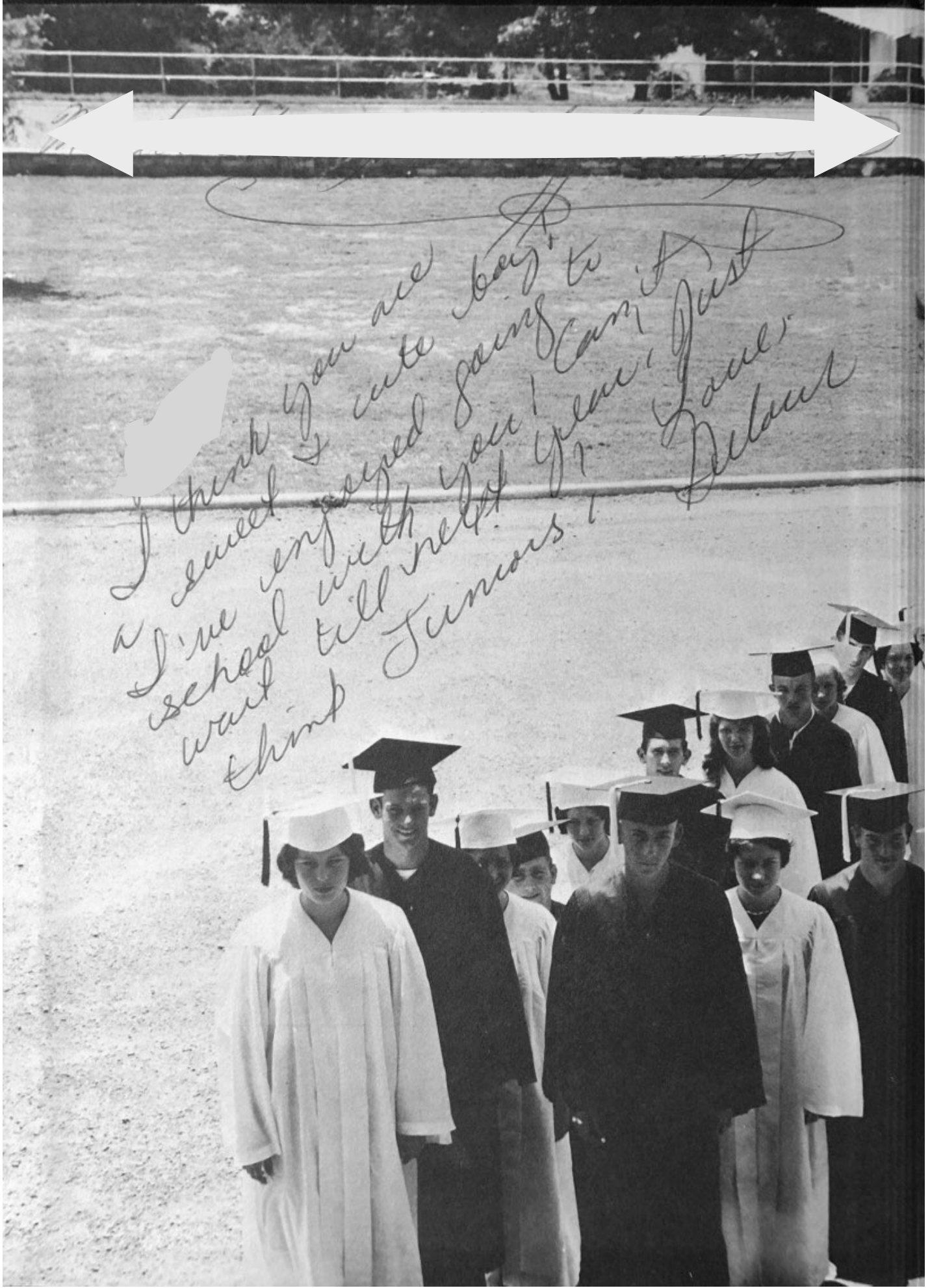

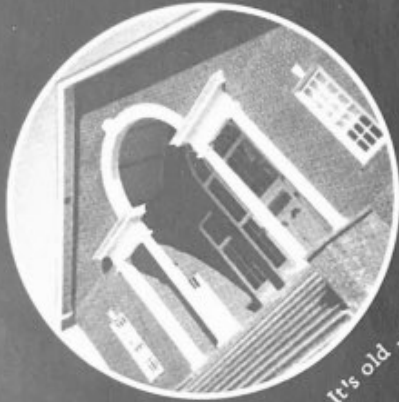

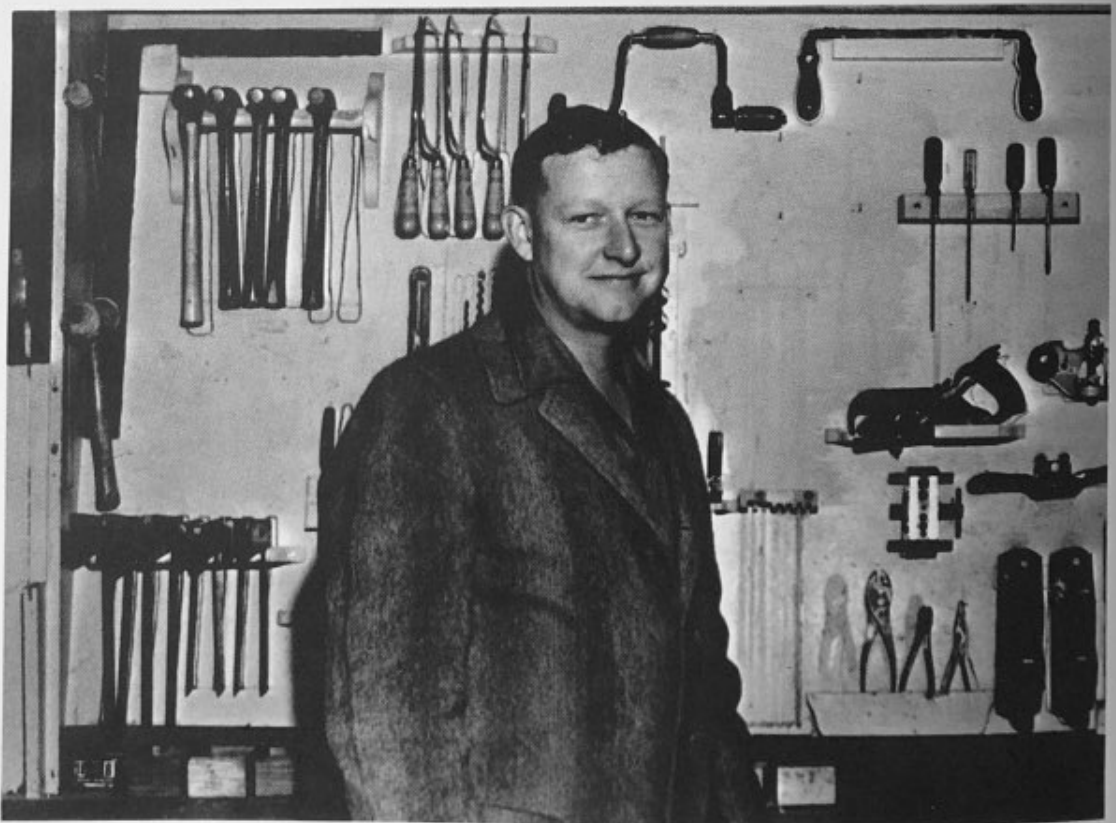
We, the Senior Class, dedicate this 1964 Mastiff to Mr. J. A. Sapp, in deep appreciation for his fruitful efforts in our school and
